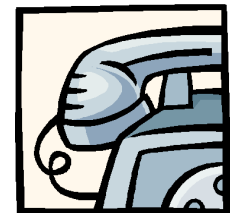

Dial 911 or the number to the police station in your town.

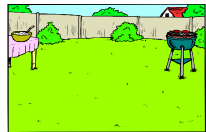
A receptionist will answer: « Police, firefighters, ambulance »

In the backyard



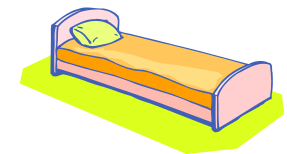
